Disclaimer: *In accordance with arbitration guidelines, all 2020 counting statistics and any relevant career totals have been extrapolated to reflect a full season, using the standard multiplier of 2.7.*

These adjustments have been applied consistently across all comparable players and are reflected in the tables and analyses presented herein.

Salary Arbitration Criteria



CBA Article VI, Section E (10):

a) The criteria will be the quality of the Player's contribution to his Club during the past season (including but not limited to his overall performance, special qualities of leadership and public appeal), the length and consistency of his career contribution, the record of the Player's past compensation, comparative baseball salaries (see paragraph (11) below for confidential salary data), the existence of any physical or mental defects on the part of the Player, and the recent performance record of the Club including but not limited to its League standing and attendance as an indication of public acceptance (subject to the exclusion stated in subparagraph (b)(i) below). Except as set forth in subsections 10(b) and 10(c) below, any evidence may be submitted which is relevant to the above criteria, and the arbitration panel shall assign such weight to the evidence as shall appear appropriate under the circumstances. The arbitration panel shall, except for a Player with five or more years of Major League service, give particular attention, for comparative salary purposes, to the contracts of Players with Major League service not exceeding one annual service group above the Player's annual service group. This shall not limit the ability of a Player or his representative, because of special accomplishment, to argue the equal relevance of salaries of Players without regard to service, and the arbitration panel shall give whatever weight to such argument as is deemed appropriate.

b) Evidence of the following shall not be admissible:

i. The financial position of the Player and the Club;

ii. Press comments, testimonials or similar material bearing on the performance of either the Player or the Club, except that recognized annual Player awards for playing excellence shall not be excluded;

iii. Offers made by either Player or Club prior to arbitration;

iv. The cost to the parties of their representatives, attorneys, etc.;

v. Salaries in other sports or occupations.

vi. The existence of the Pre-Arbitration Performance Bonus Program described in Article XV(D), including the criteria and any amounts earned pursuant to the Program.

vii. The potential impact of the hearing on the Player's eligibility for termination pay under paragraph (3) above.

c) Admissible Statistics. Only publicly available statistics shall be admissible. For purposes of this provision, publicly available statistics shall include data available through subscription-only websites (e.g., Baseball Prospectus). Statistics and data generated through the use of performance technology, wearable technology, or "STATCAST", whether publicly available or not, shall not be admissible.

Jarren Duran : Background



- Jarren Duran was drafted in the 7th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Boston Red Sox, known for his speed but lacking a proven offensive track record. He spent the next three years in the minors, transitioning to the outfield, but his impact at higher levels was limited.
- In 2021, Duran made his MLB debut, appearing in 33 games and posting a .215 batting average with a -0.7 rWAR. His offensive struggles (40 strikeouts in 112 plate appearances) limited his contributions.
- In 2022, he played 58 games, hitting .221 with a -0.1 rWAR. His defensive versatility improved, but his offensive output fell below league average.
- In 2023, Duran posted solid numbers over 102 games (.295/.346/.482, 24 stolen bases, and 34 doubles). However, he missed the final 38 games due to a left great toe injury, limiting his availability during a critical stretch of the season.
- In 2024, Duran had a strong year, hitting .285 with 21 home runs, 75 RBIs, and 34 stolen bases.

Application Of Salary Arbitration Criteria



Platform Year

Duran delivered his best season to date, leading the league in doubles (48) and posting an .834 OPS. However, his high strikeout total (160) and a modest .342 on-base percentage reflect areas for improvement despite his strong overall numbers.

Length and Consistency of Career Contributions

Over his 2.155 years of MLB service, Duran has played in 353 games but missed 64 days on the IL, spent significant time in the minors, and only recently demonstrated consistent contributions after two below-average seasons (-0.8 rWAR combined in 2021-2022).

Past Compensation

Duran has earned the league minimum throughout his career, reflecting his developmental status and limited contributions prior to 2023. While his 2024 performance warrants consideration for a higher salary, his earlier compensation accurately reflects his past value.

Comparable Salaries

Duran's platform season, while productive, does not outweigh the lack of consistent career contributions seen in similarly situated players, justifying a salary aligned with the \$3,500,000 club filing number.

Existence of Physical Defects

The existence of a physical defect is not an issue in this case.

Team Success

The Red Sox missed the postseason in 2022, 2023, and 2024. While Duran's contributions in 2023 and 2024 were solid, they were not sufficient to elevate the team to playoff contention, reflecting a limited overall impact on team success.

- Duran made his major league debut in July 2021 after starting the season in Triple-A Worcester, showcasing promise as a young outfielder.
- Over 33 games with the Red Sox, he posted a .215 batting average and .578 OPS, with 2 home runs and 40 strikeouts, reflecting challenges in adjusting to MLB pitching.
- Duran was optioned to Triple-A Worcester multiple times throughout the season due to inconsistent performance and health concerns.
- Despite being added to the Wild Card roster, Duran did not appear in the game, underscoring his limited impact during the Red Sox's playoff run.

- Duran began the 2022 season with Triple-A Worcester, earning multiple call-ups but struggling to solidify a consistent role with the Red Sox.
- In 58 MLB games, he posted a .221 batting average, .645 OPS, and struck out 63 times, with modest contributions of 3 home runs, 13 doubles, and 7 stolen bases.
- Despite flashes of potential, Duran's performance lacked the consistency needed to establish himself as a reliable major-league contributor.
- The Red Sox finished the season with a disappointing 78-84 record, placing last in the AL East, with Duran's limited impact reflecting his ongoing developmental status.

- Duran began the 2023 season on the Red Sox's Opening Day roster but struggled with consistency at times, striking out 90 times in 102 games, contributing to the team's offensive challenges.
- While his .295 batting average and 34 doubles were career highs, his power production remained limited, with just 8 home runs and 40 RBIs across 362 plate appearances.
- A season-ending injury in August cut short his first full MLB campaign, raising questions about his durability and ability to sustain performance over an entire season.
- The Red Sox finished the year 78-84, missing the playoffs once again, with Duran's contributions overshadowed by the team's lackluster overall performance.

- Duran played a full 160-game season in 2024, striking out 160 times, ranking 10th in the American League, indicating ongoing challenges with plate discipline.
- While he led MLB in doubles (48) and triples (14), his power numbers included 21 home runs and 75 RBIs, raising questions about his ability to drive in runs at an elite level.
- Despite ranking 5th league-wide in WAR (8.7), much of Duran’s value stemmed from extra-base hits and speed, leaving gaps in his ability to deliver balanced offensive contributions.
- The Red Sox finished the 2024 season at 81-81, failing to make the playoffs, with Duran’s strong individual numbers unable to translate into team success.

Length and Consistency of Career Contributions

Accumulating Limited Service Time Over Four Seasons

Jarren Duran has required **four seasons** to accumulate just 2.155 years of MLB service time, narrowly meeting the Super Two threshold by only 23 days.



Minimal WAR Contributions in First Three Seasons



Duran posted a combined rWAR of 1.3 across his first three seasons, demonstrating a **lack of consistent impact** over a prolonged period.

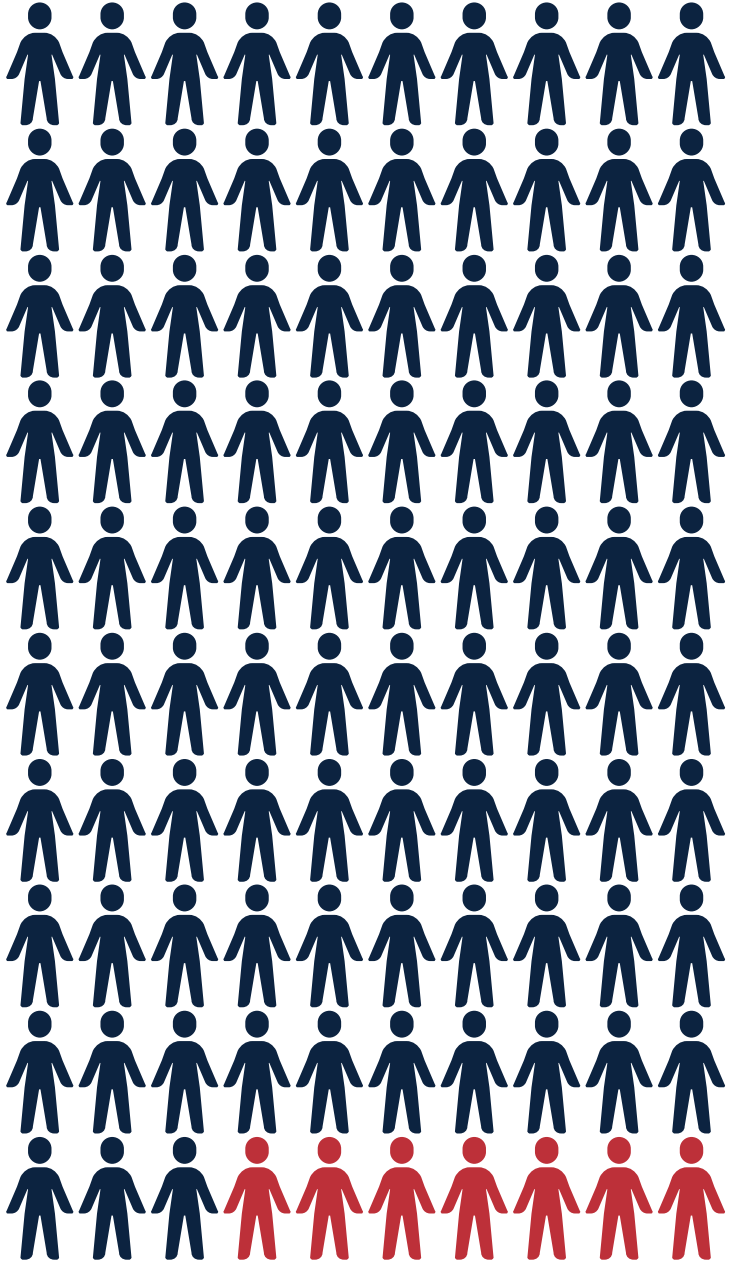


Duran's **cumulative rWAR for 2021 and 2022 was -0.8**, emphasizing his struggles to contribute positively to the team during his initial seasons.

2021 and 2022 Cumulative WAR Ranking

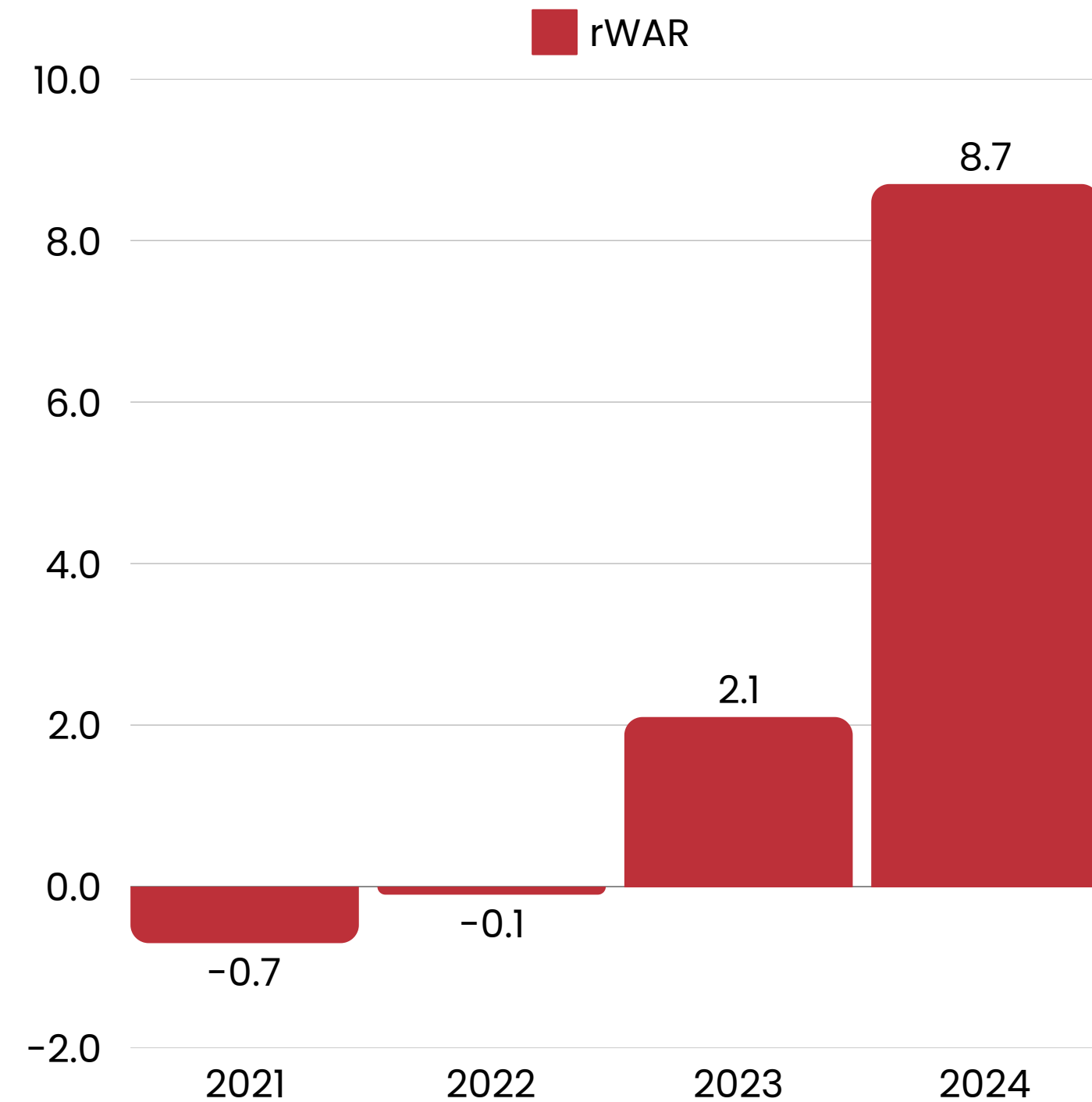
From 2021 to 2022, Duran ranked 837th out of 900 MLB players in rWAR, placing him in the **bottom 7th percentile for value** during this period.

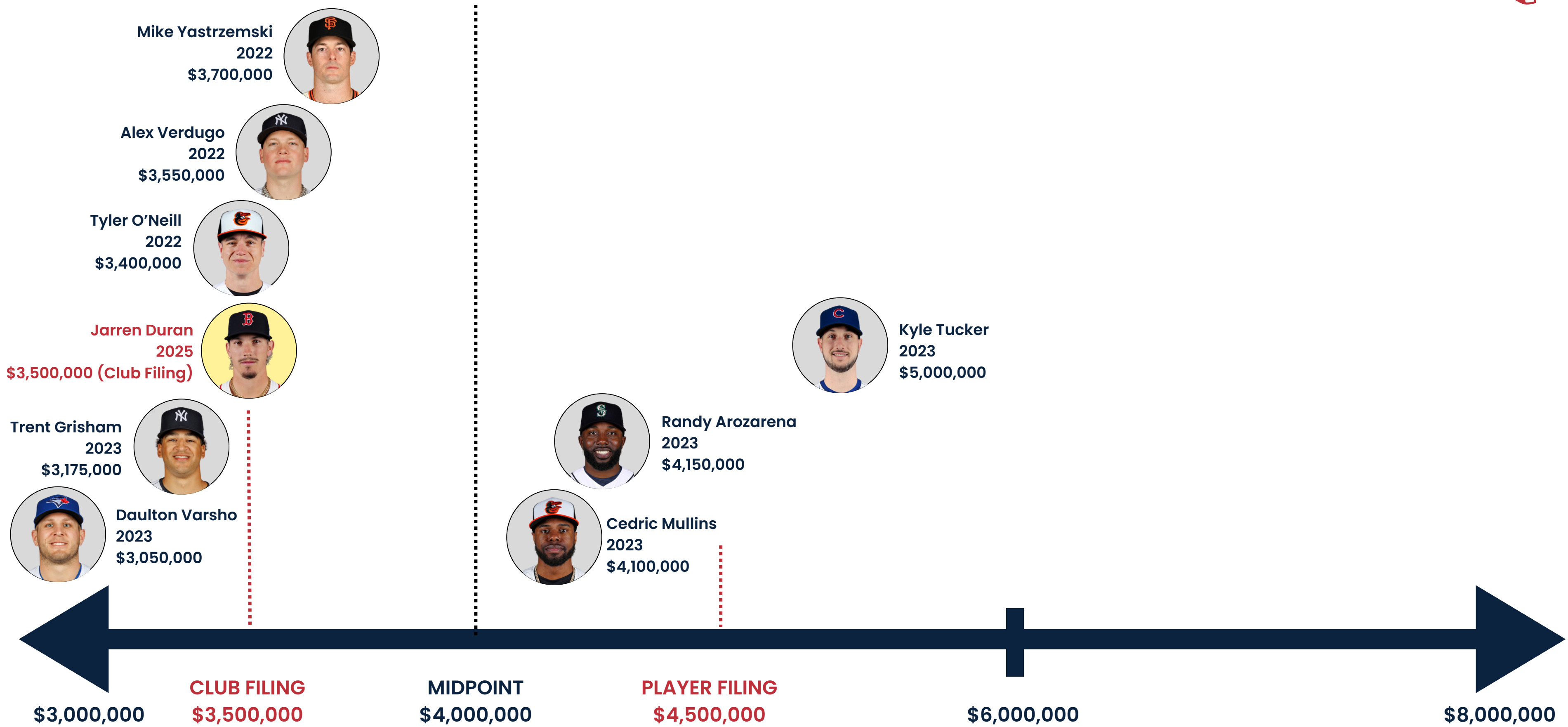
