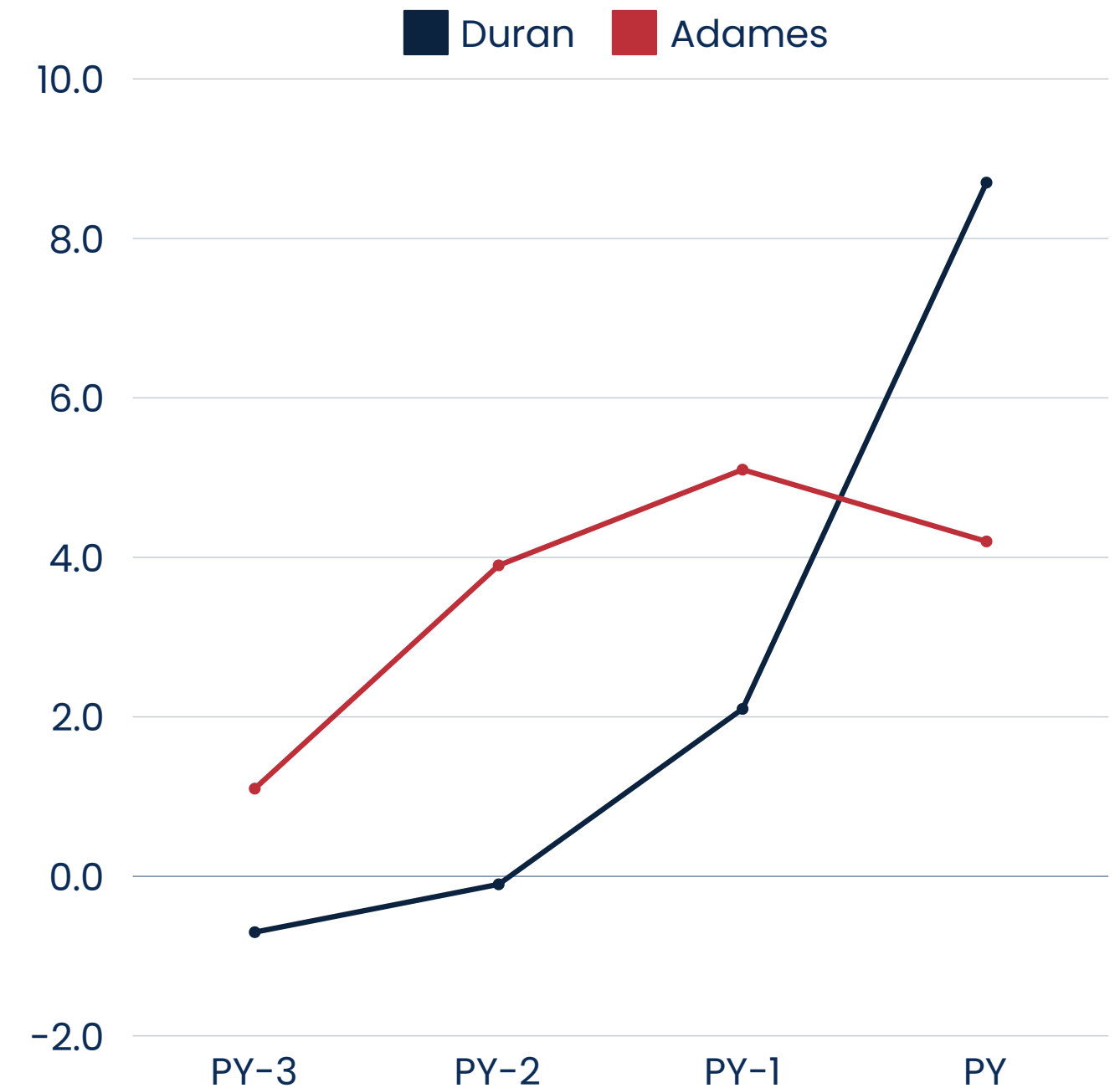

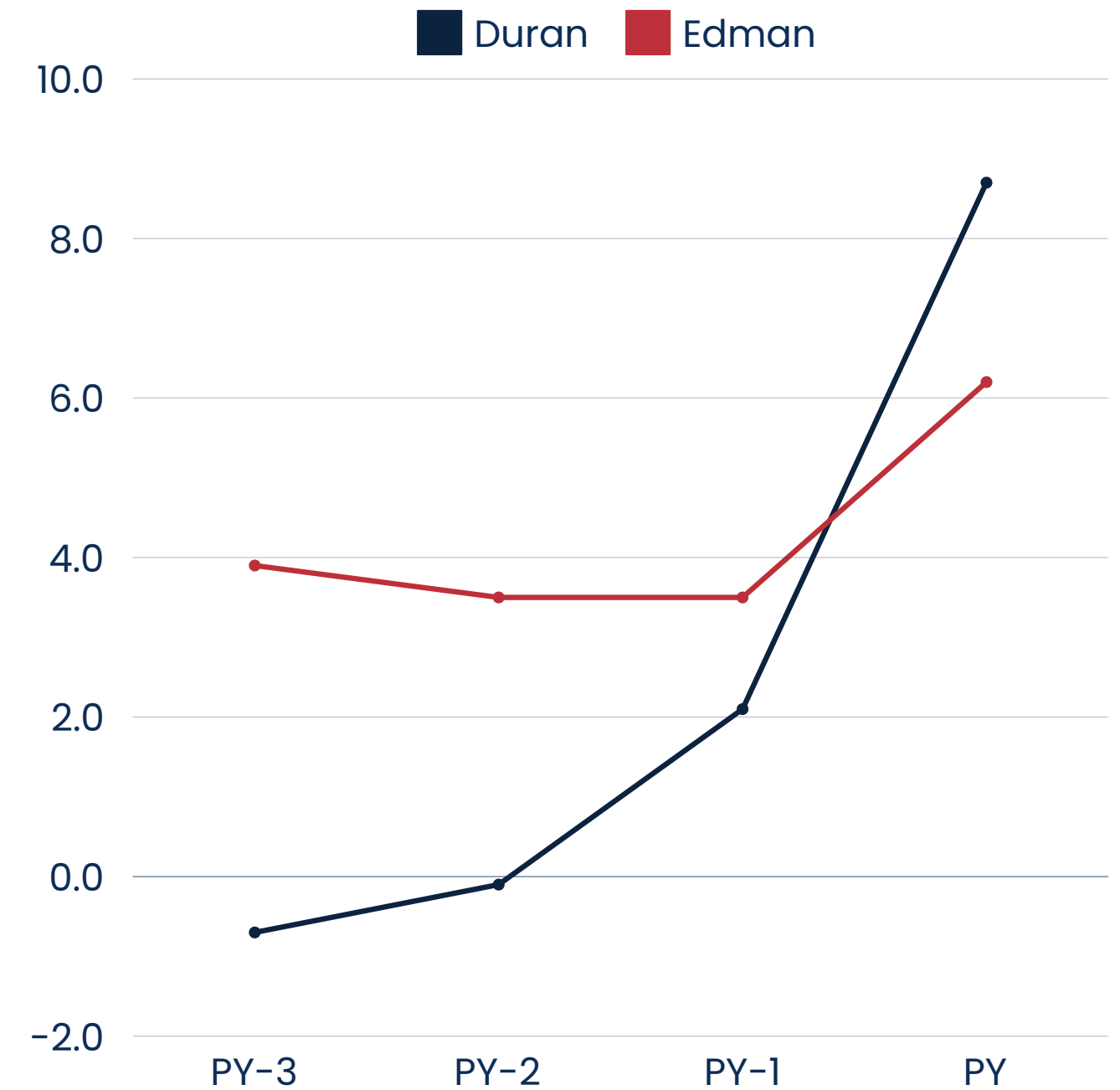

Duran and Yastrzemski have **comparable career opportunities**, but Yastrzemski's higher rWAR (12.4 vs. 10.0), 73 home runs, and 1,551 plate appearances underscore his ability to provide more consistent offensive impact.

Duran and O'Neill both have the **same career rWAR** (10.0 vs. 10.0) and time on the IL (64 days vs. 79 days), but O'Neill's higher home run totals (67 vs. 34) highlight a key difference in offensive contributions.
